Preparing Our Pupils for the Future

Our students have done well in learning despite COVID19

- Singapore had the highest proportions Reading, Mathematics and Science of top performers achieving proficiency level 5 or 6, across all participating education systems for the PISA 2022.
- Our students have shown that they are good in mathematical reasoning, can distinguish between relevant and irrelevant information, and use computational thinking as they solve complex problems in a variety of modern contexts.

Preparing Our Pupils for the Future

What can schools do?

- Schools cannot just have a *narrow definition of success*. We need to appreciate the <u>diversity of strengths</u> required for our society to be much more <u>resilient</u>. We need to respect one another for their <u>diverse talents</u>.
- Why every child a creator? New ideas and solutions for tomorrow's world.
- Why everyone a connector? A reason to bring people together to value-add to society and the world.
- Why everyone a contributor? Everyone must have a sense that they are able to do so according to their own talents.



Focus For P2 Pupil Development

- Building mental and emotional resilience in pupils (Building self-esteem and confidence)
- Strengthening Teacher-Student Relationship (TSR) and Student-Student Relationship.
 (Relationships, working in teams and collaboration)
- Cultivating the right habits and mindset (Self-discipline and self-directed)

Term 2, Week 10

- E-PTC Conference : 3-way conference (Parent-Teacher-Child)
- The child is at the centre of the discussion and will be the one who shares his/her learning with parents.





P2 Math Fun Day @ School

 Pupils have a fun time applying their learning to games designed according to level learning outcomes.





P2 Fun with Math @ Home

 Pupils enjoy playing Math games with their families at home to continue their learning beyond school.







P2 PAL

- Focus on SEL Competencies and acquiring life skills (e.g. Problem solving etc).
- Sports and Games / Outdoor Education Learning to make and play traditional games / toys as well as learning to navigate around the school.
- Visual Art Integration the arts into learning using recycled materials to construct artifacts of learning.
- Performing Arts Learn more about cultures of Sinagpore's ethnic groups through songs and dance.





P2 Neighbourhood Walk

- Foster an understanding of the local community and neighbourhood. Our pupils can learn about the different places, services, and people within their immediate surroundings.
- Introduce our pupils to the diverse cultures and social aspects present in their community.
 This can include visits to local markets, parks, community centers, and meeting people from different backgrounds.



Schoolwide Reading Programme

- Extensive Reading period (ER) in P1 & P2.
- I Love Literature for P1 to P4.
- Fortnightly School Library Visits (Fengshan Cove).
- I am a Reading Champion activity booklet.
- Read@any NLB Library (Parent-child bonding through reading).

School-Based Assessment Changes for Primary Schools

2019 From 2023

- Remove weighted assessments in P1 and P2 (include P2 End of Year Exam)
- Consider non-academic factors in class allocation (More details later on)
- From P3 onwards, to conduct no more than 1 weighted assessment per subject, per school term, on top of any Mid Year Exam and End of Year Exam.

 Remove Mid-Year Exam for all levels (P1 to P6)



PERI Holistic Assessment

Rationale

- To support students' learning and development
 - Provide on-going feedback for learning and improvement
 - Build confidence and desire to learn

Test Scope

- Syllabus-related focussed
- English, Mathematics, Science (P3-P6), Mother Tongue and PAM (P.E., Art and Music)



PERI Holistic Assessment

- Holistic Assessment (HA) are bite-size assessments, including performance based tasks.
- End of Year Assessment is a one sitting assessment (from P3 to P6).
- Important for parents to ensure that your child is present in school for the assessments. However, if your child is unwell, please see a doctor and get a medical certificate.


